Outreach

Christ and The Epiphany Church actively serves those in need in our local community and beyond. Some of our outreach ministries include food and clothing collections for the East Haven Food Pantry, Midnight Run; providing food and basic necessities for the homeless, East Haven United; a collaboration of the faith community, Global Mission Fund, and the Good Shepherd Thrift Store.



We also support the East Haven Community Kitchen and the many self-help groups that meet in our facility.

History

Christ and The Epiphany Church was established in 1963 as the result of a merging of Christ Church (East Haven, built in 1789), The Church of The Epiphany (New Haven, built in 1901) and St. Mark's Mission (Momauguin section of East Haven, organized in 1929). Our church was consecrated in 1964 and contains many memorials and furnishings from all three worship communities.

From the Church of The Epiphany came our Caen stone baptismal font, the 20-bell chime from its tower, and the hand-carved plaque of the Epiphany scene installed on the front of the pulpit. The brass altar appointments and original flags were from Christ Church.

The Chapel is furnished with memorials from both churches and from St. Mark's Mission. The Children's Chapel contains a stained glass window from the Church of The Epiphany.
